How to Trust an Enterprise Developer on iOS/iPadOS

Step I: Attempt to Open the App

After installing the enterprise app, try opening it. You'll see a message stating 'Untrusted Enterprise Developer'. Tap 'Cancel' to dismiss.



Step 2: Navigate to Device Management Settings

- I. Open the Settings app on your iOS device.
- 2. Tap 'General'.
- 3. Scroll down and select 'VPN & Device Management'.



Step 3: Locate the Developer Profile

Under 'Enterprise App', locate and tap the profile named 'Facility Solutions Group'.
